

Close the achievement gap and make sure our children are kindergarten ready

- 74.64% of subsidy children are in high quality childcare programs versus 57.5% in 2014
 - O With 3,100 more children in 4 & 5 Star programs
- 4,953 more children per month are receiving child care assistance vs. 2014
- Expanded NM Pre-K to **3 year olds** in FY16 and have increased the number of children in Pre-K by **38%** since FY11

Ensure our children are safe and cared for

- Foster homes have increased by 21% over the past two and a half years
- 1,073 children participating in the Protective Services At-Risk childcare program started in FY16
- Relative Foster Care Placements have increased from 19.6% in 2015 to 25.4% in 2017
- Improved placement stability from 4.9 moves in foster care in 2015 to **2.5 moves** in 2017
- CYFD and PED's summer food program have served over 16.5 million meals to children since 2011

Engage the community in our fight to make New Mexico the best place to be a kid

- The PullTogether campaign has reached 1.34 million New Mexicans
- 76,000 users are on PullTogether.org, with over 181,000 page views
- Distributed over 225,000 pamphlets with resources for families
- Over 1400 calls to the Resource and Referral line

Ensure our children and families receive appropriate services

- Worked with MAD and BHSD increase Medicaid approved Adolescent Intensive OutpatientPrograms across NM to
 15 sites vs. 11 sites in 2015
- CYFD Community Behavioral Health Clinicians now serving both Juvenile Justice Services and Protective Services and implement a system to measure service effectiveness
- Doubled the number of Infant Mental Health Teams since FY14

Make sure our children are prepared to be contributing members of society

- 125 JJS facility clients have received a GED and 72 clients received a high school diploma since 2014
- Implemented Life Skills, and Vocational / Certification programming in JJS facilities
 - o Re-established team athletics program and Color Guard
 - o Implementation of Dog Obedience Training Program
 - o Developing Basic OSHA and Safe Service certifications
 - Attending College and Career Fairs
